**Position Specification**

Applicants should have (i) a higher degree, at least to Master level, in English language teaching or applied linguistics, with training (at least at Bachelor level) in English language and/or education and (ii) proven record of teaching excellence, and relevant experience in teaching EAP, ESP and content-based courses at tertiary level.

The appointee will be responsible for (a) teaching University English language courses; (b) designing e-learning materials; and (c) assisting in curriculum development and administrative assignments.

**Salary and Fringe Benefits**

Salary will be highly competitive, commensurate with qualifications and experience. Appointments will be made under the establishment of CUHK (SZ) for an initial period of two years and statutory benefits will be provided according to the prevailing labor laws applicable in the PRC. The appointee is expected to commence work around May 2014, in preparation for the start of teaching in September 2014.
